Athlete Protection Training course ( <u>www.usaswimming.org/protect</u> )
Current and previous members can access the course at any time. New non-athlete members must
register through their LSC before getting access to this online course, which takes approximately 60
minutes to complete and is offered at no charge. New members cannot initiate the course until their
membership application has been processed by their LSC, so it is recommended that new members
wait ten days after mailing their application before attempting to log in to take the course. Once their
membership application has been processed, the log in procedure can be completed. (An error
message will appear during the log in if the new member's application hasn't been processed yet.)

Your LSC will be notified automatically when you have passed the background check and online athlete protection training. Once all membership requirements have been met, your LSC will mail a membership card to you.
